REACH CERTIFICATION

To Whom It May Concern

We would like to inform you that we have assessed whether Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council (**REACH**) is applicable to the products produced by us:

PLAZIT 2001 (DUNS No. 53-254-1521)

- 1. The products and their packaging are 'articles' under REACH, therefore they do not require registration.
- 2. They do not intentionally release substances under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use.
- 3. The substances in the articles do not have to be registered under REACH.
- 4. We hereby declare that none of the products that we supply contain any substances on its own, in mixtures or in articles listed in the most updated Candidate List, in concentrations exceeding 0.1 % (w/w). (See Candidate List for authorization, last updated on 18.6.2012, which contains 84 SVHC)
