- **MERCURY**
- **HEXAVALANT CHROMIUM**
- **POLYBROMINATED BIPHENYL**
- **POLYBROMINATED DIPHENYL ETHER**

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**Cadmium, Lead, Chrome, Mercury Total: < 100 mg / kg**

**Phthalate: DEHP, DBP, BBP Total < 1000 mg / kg**

**DINP, DNOP, DIDP Total < 1000 mg / kg**

**DIHP < 1000 mg / kg**

**PAK ZEK01.08: < 10mg/kg**

**BfR: < 0,2 mg / kg**

**Min. < 10 mg / kg ( Kat. 2 ) , besser < 0,2 mg / kg ( Kat. 1 )**
